JOB RESPONSIBILITIES

- Screen and clean teeth and gums
- Performs X-rays and dental molds
- Apply fluoride treatments and sealants
- Provide care for gum disease
- Educate on flossing and brushing

GET A DEGREE

Dental hygienists must earn a college degree in Dental Hygiene. This can be either a 2-year or a 4-year degree at:

- University of Hawaii Maui College, 2-year associate's degree
- University of Hawaii at Manoa, 4-year bachelor's degree
- Some mainland colleges also offer these degrees

GET LICENSED

You need to take an exam for a license from the State of Hawaii and complete continuing education classes each year.

GET HIRED

68% of the respondents in an HDS Foundation survey said there is a need for dental hygienists in Hawaii. Job opportunities can be found online or by approaching dental offices.
